Background

Principals, in consultation with their staffs and community stakeholders, are responsible for determining the hours of operation of their schools. Alberta Education requirements, the needs of students, transportation interconnections and other pertinent variables are to guide the decisions of school leaders in this regard.

Procedures

- 1. Time Schedule During the Day All Schools
 - 1.1 Time schedules in all schools may be arranged to suit the needs of each individual school and its programs; however, all schedules over the course of the Division's school year must provide for:
 - 1.1.1 At least a minimum of nine hundred and fifty (950) hours of instruction for students in grades 1-9; and
 - 1.1.2 One thousand (1,000) hours of instruction for students in grades 10-12.
 - 1.2 The regularly established hours of the day for each school may not be changed without the knowledge and prior approval of the Superintendent.
- 2. Early Dismissal of School
 - 2.1 No school shall be dismissed before the regular hour except with the knowledge and prior approval of the Superintendent or designate.
