Background

Teachers directed to work during the summer outside the school year or on other holidays during the school year shall be compensated for those days of work.

Procedures

- 1. This Administrative Procedure will not apply to principals and vice-principals.
- 2. Teachers (except principals and vice-principals) required by the Superintendent or designate in writing to work during the summer or other holidays will be paid 1/200th per day as per their placement on the grid. Where mutually agreed, Teachers (except principals and vice-principals) may take time-in-lieu for work during the summer.
- 3. Summer school teachers shall be paid 1/200th per day as per their placement on the grid.
