Background

Teachers, bus drivers and principals assume responsibility for the care and custody of children during school hours and school sponsored activities.

Procedures

- 1. Before a child is released from care and custody during the instructional day, the Principal or teacher in charge must ensure that parent/guardian permission is given.
- 2. The bus driver is responsible for the discharge of students at the designated location.
