The button on the home page will take you to this window, log in to the PowerSchool Parent Portal.

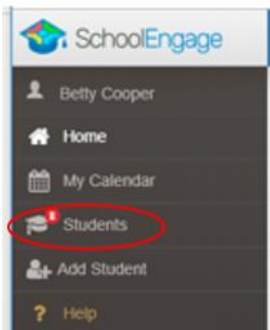
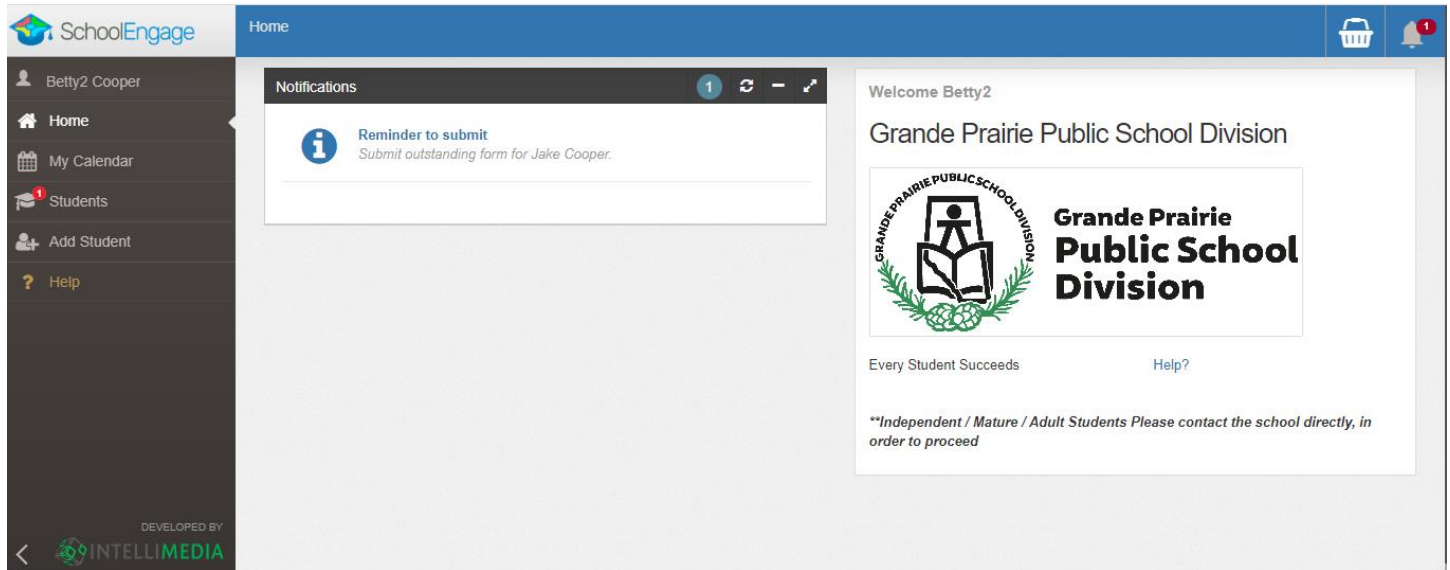

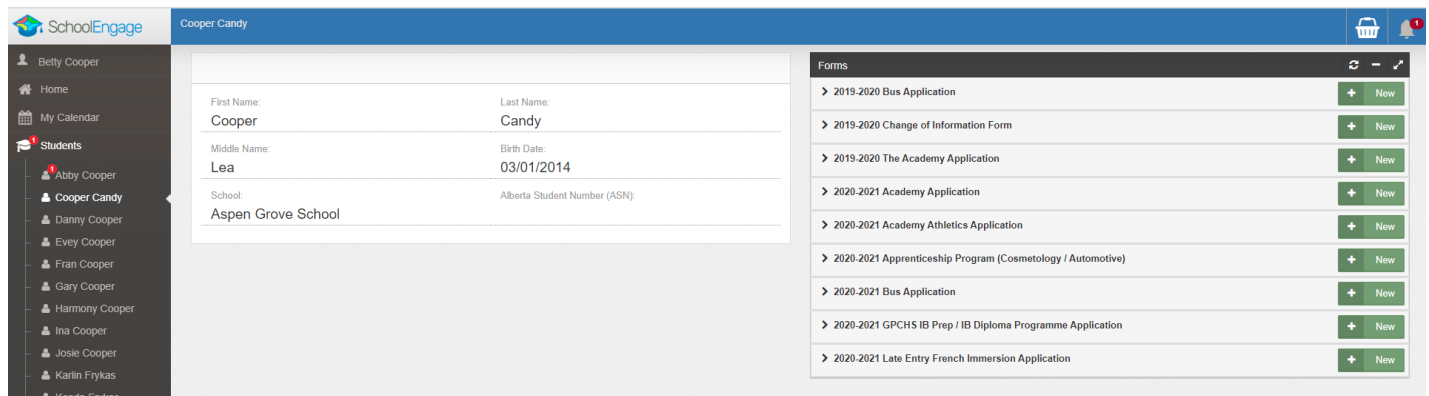
