Background

Any student who willfully or irresponsibly damages or destroys school property is to be financially responsible for such damage.

Procedures

- 1. The Principal shall report all vandalism, break-ins, or burglaries promptly to the Director of Operations or designate.
- 2. The Director of Operations will notify the Secretary-Treasurer and RCMP when necessary.
- 3. Students who destroy, deface, or steal school property:
 - 3.1 Will be required to pay in full for repairs, restitution, or replacement of the property involved.
 - 3.2 May be suspended from school in addition to making repayment.
 - 3.3 In flagrant cases, may be permanently expelled from school upon Board approval.
 - 3.4 Will be prosecuted in the proper courts with the complete cooperation of school authorities.
