Background

The student's primary responsibility is to conduct himself/herself in a manner which will not cause the bus driver to divert his/her attention from driving the bus.

Procedures

- 1. Bus Passes
 - 1.1 Eligible students must apply for a bus pass and pick up their bus pass from their school once it has been approved and printed.
 - 1.2 All students must present a bus pass to scan on and off of the bus
- 2. Students must arrive at their bus stop 5 minutes before their scheduled stop time. Drivers are not obligated to wait past the scheduled pick-up time.
- 3. Students are expected to wait away from the street, be considerate of private property and avoid creating a disturbance.
- 4. Students shall observe the same behavioural expectations that prevail in school and further shall:
 - 4.1 Board and de-board one (1) at a time in an orderly manner;
 - 4.2 Be seated quickly and quietly;
 - 4.3 Obey the bus driver at all times;
 - 4.4 Keep the aisles clear of all obstructions, including feet and legs;
 - 4.5 Keep head, arms and legs inside open windows.
- 5. Adequate supervision will be provided during bus loading after school.
- 6. Alcohol, vaping, or drugs (except prescription) of any type shall not be allowed on the bus.
- 7. Items
 - 7.1 Musical instruments no longer than a saxophone may be taken on a bus.
 - 7.2 Students shall leave equipment in the area designated by the driver. The driver may refuse to carry large items that obstruct aisles or doors or are a danger in any way.
 - 7.3 Skateboards are not allowed on the school bus.

- 7.4 Skates may be taken on the bus only if the blades are covered by guards.
- 8. Misconduct
 - 8.1 Any breach of this Administrative Procedure will be reported to the Principal concerned, who may take whatever disciplinary action he/she sees fit.
 - 8.2 If suspension of bus riding privileges results, the parents, the Contractor, and the Transportation Co-ordinator will be informed.
 - 8.3 Continued problems will be referred to the Director of Student Supports for further action.
