**Background**

The Division recognizes the value of the use of regular, organized safety patrols in the safe conduct of students on and off Division property, especially in peak student traffic periods.

**Procedures**

1. The Principal or designate of each elementary school may organize a school safety patrol program to instruct, direct, and control students in crossing streets at or near the schools, but the members of any such patrol shall have no authority over any persons other than students.
2. The Principal or designate shall ensure that student members receive adequate instruction in the appropriate duties and procedures.
3. Participation
  - 3.1 Student members shall serve only with the written consent of their parents or guardians [Safety Patrol Permission Form \(Form 311-1\)](#).
  - 3.2 Student members will be selected on the basis of their maturity and responsibility.
