BUSINESS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MEETINGS

2024-2025 CALENDAR DEVELOPMENT

Trustees asked in an earlier meeting for information in order to prepare for upcoming school council meetings. The dates developed below are developed in consultation with other divisions, align with provincial testing dates and support the delivery of the school-based PL days monthly throughout the school year. The information below will be reviewed with School Councils at the Council of School Councils meeting on November 30 and a draft calendar will be shared in the next Board package and distributed to staff for review at their December or January staff meetings.

- Staff startup days: Wednesday, August 28 to Friday, August 30
- Christmas break: Monday December 23 to Friday, January 3.
- Easter break: March 31 to April 4
- Last day for students: June 25
- Last day for staff: June 26

SCHOOL ENGAGEMENTS

As previously discussed, the system leadership team will be meeting in person with all schools on Monday Dec 4, Friday Dec 5, Monday Jan 8, Friday Feb 2, and Monday Feb 5 to begin the initial engagement for the updating of the 3-Year Educational Plan. Evidence does not exist that suggests the 3 existing priorities should be changed, and the focus of the division-wide staff engagement process will be for the purpose of identifying the evidence and strategies associated with each of the 7 focus outcomes for the 3 priority areas.

MEETING WITH CITY MANAGER

ITEMS FOR INFORMATION

On November 9 I met with the new City Manager, Shane Bourke, to welcome him to his new role and discuss the mutual benefit to our organizations of keeping each other informed of planning that has the potential to impact each organization. I am committed to sharing our capital planning and other highlights as they develop throughout the school year that may be beneficial for City administration and Mayor and Council to be aware of.

STAFF WELLNESS DAY 2024 PLANNING

It is with great anticipation I can announce the Staff Wellness Committee has been successful in booking Dr Robyn Hanley-Dafoe to present a keynote address to all staff again. Trustees are invited to attend the keynote and if possible, I look forward to Board Chair Nellis taking the opportunity to join me in addressing our staff to start the day.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE 360: PROMOTION, PLACEMENT, ACCELERATION, and RETENTION

Edits have been made to AP360, to ensure it is consistent with the practice that currently exists in schools and to improve the clarity of sections of the AP. The work to update this procedure was led by the Director of Inclusive Learning, Nancy Gorgichuk and was supported by the system leadership team and school administrators during all administrator and principal meeting time.

One key feature in the AP is that the placement of students through the practice of retention is strongly discouraged and is not promoted by the Grande Prairie Public School Division as an effective support for student success. Although educational research indicates there is little or no benefit to retention, there may be consideration in primary grades (K-3) when there are concerns about the student's developmental readiness, which may improve with additional time. Should retention be considered for a student, it will only occur after extensive discussion between parents, school, and system staff. Retention will not be used as a remediation or special education strategy. Additionally, the placement of students through the practice of acceleration may be considered if it is determined to be in the best interest of the student.

PROVINCIAL DIGITAL ASSESSMENT PLATFORM

The first digital written response diploma exams were administered on Alberta's new digital assessment platform in early November. The initial rollout was not without challenges, and divisions provided feedback to Alberta Education for the purpose of improving the platform ahead of the January diploma exam administration. Appreciation is extended to high school administration and IT department staff for their efforts to support the initial writing for the small number of students who wrote, and for their commitment to continuing to work with Alberta Education to ensure a smooth experience for students at the end of semester one.

Alberta Education will be making funding available to divisions who require support to improve their technical infrastructure to support provincial achievement tests and diploma exams on the digital assessment platform.

MEETING WITH THE NORTHWESTERN POLYTECHNIC BOARD OF GOVERNORS

A date for the Board's initial meeting with the Board of Governors for Northwest Polytechnic has been selected for January 11, 2024 at the NWP campus. More information about parking and meeting location will be shared in a calendar invitation soon. The following topics are proposed for consideration, and the Advocacy and Engagement committee will likely want to hear from Trustees regarding other topics.

- Given this is the first meeting of the organizations, it may be valuable to share priorities for both advocacy and operations.
- It may be a valuable exercise to then explore the areas each organization has in common, including both challenges and opportunities.
- Sharing long-term priorities.
- The Board may specifically want to address the importance of seeing the NWP Teacher Education degree come online as a key strategy to help area students enter the pathway to a teaching degree.

HIGH SCHOOL COMPLETION PLANNING

The high school principals and system leadership team met November 22 for the first High School Planning meeting of the year. The meeting focused on exploring the factors that impact high school completion. Topics discussed included reviewing the high school completion intervention funding, reviewing the results of the planning to support the success of 4th and 5th year students, exploring the potential of offering summer school programming, and reviewing off campus and dual credit programming.

COLLEGE OF ALBERTA SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENTS (CASS) ZONE 1 MEETING

The CASS Zone 1 meeting was held on Friday, November 24. In addition to providing updates on, and sharing of highlights of the regular work of school system leaders in the division, a presentation was made by the Chair of the Professional Conduct and Competency General Panel regarding implementation of the new Teacher and Teacher Leader conduct and disciplinary complaint process.
