ITEMS FOR INFORMATION

PUTTING EMPLOYER AND EMPLOYEE PERSPECTIVES TO WORK

Director of Human Resources, Tammie Maurer, Associate Superintendent Guindon, and Superintendent McDonald attended the Chamber of Commerce's presentation on recent research into regional labour market needs. The partnership between the Chamber, the City of Grande Prairie, the County of Grande Prairie, the Municipal District of Greenview, and Northwestern Polytechnic began in 2019 and has resulted in the development of a Regional Workforce Development Partnership. This partnership will be used to create a collaborative regional workforce development strategic action plan and contains information that has the potential to inform future recruiting efforts. ALL ADMINISTRATION PROFESSIONAL LEARNING and FEBRUARY PRINCIPALS MEETING

The professional learning time was used to provide school administration teams time to continue to plan for, and share with other school leadership teams, implementation of the Optimum Learning Framework and to continue their planning to support student attendance.

In addition to reviewing the timelines for receiving nominations for the Edwin Parr award and providing updates re: the division website implementation and digital communications practices, the afternoon with principals was focused on inclusive learning planning and a review of the role of the Learning Support Teacher in schools.

ADMINISTRATION STAFFING UPDATE

The staffing process for the 2024-2025 school year is underway, and Matt Pepper, current principal at Isabel Campbel Public School, will be relocating to assume the same role at Ecole Montrose. Additionally, Kendra Stewart, who has been in the acting Vice Principal role at Alexander Forbes this year, will be remaining at the school on an ongoing basis.

The competition to select a principal for Isabel Campbell Public School is ongoing and will close the week of February 26

LEADERSHIP FOR TOMORROW

The most recent session of the Division's Leadership for Tomorrow took place on Thursday, February 22. The focus of the session is on the continuation of developing their understanding of the practices related to instructional leadership. Participants were guided through reflection on their leadership-focused inquiry question and provided the opportunity to continue to develop their skills to engage in generative dialogue with teachers for the purpose of supporting teacher professional growth planning.

3-YEAR EDUCATION PLAN DEVELOPMENT UPDATE

Planning for the updating of the division's 3-Year Education Plan continues. The staff engagement to learn their perspectives re: strategies for supporting student growth and achievement and successful high school completion will open February 26 and closes March 7. Student and parent perspectives included in recent school and division data is being reviewed at the same time to inform planning and a draft review of the plan will be presented for review at Board's May 1 Planning Retreat.

- tour of Fort-de-France. See the colourful market, Cathedrale St-Louis, the Schoelcher Library, and admire local artisans' work as you walk through the urban park Place de la Savane
- Creole Cooking workshop
- Jardin de Batala; The garden contains about 3,000 varieties of tropical plants from around the world, including 300 types of palm trees
- Drive along the Route de la Trace through the tropical forest to reach the area of Le Morne Rouge
- Visit the Musee de la Banane and learn all about the process of a banana plantation
- former sugar estate of Marie Joseph Rose Tascher de la Pagerie, who later became Empress Josephine. The museum, a picturesque stone building, is her birthplace
- Discover La Savane des Esclaves, an Amerindian village. With a local guide learn about this village of slaves who fled the plantations to take refuge in nature and created a way of life with specific customs, authentic Creole huts, a creole garden and a local language
