

Programming

Each year, families can choose to opt-in to this program by having their child attend one of the Music Program of Choice schools. The program is taught by teachers who have specialized training in music education.

Each grade of the program focuses on different skills and areas of music learning. Students in the program will also receive presentations from guest musicians and participate in clinics, concerts, and music-focused field trips.



Grade 5

Students will have the opportunity to establish a strong foundation in all areas of musical knowledge and will participate in singing, rhythm and instrument playing activities. Students will play Orff Instruments (xylophones/glockenspiels), Ukulele, Recorder, Non-pitched Percussion and World drums. Students will perform throughout the year and will participate in the Grande Prairie and Division Music Festival in the spring.



Grade 6

Students will expand their musical learning on the instruments studied in grade 5 and also be introduced to the instruments of the Band (Flute, Clarinet, Trumpet, Trombone, Baritone) and Orchestra (Violin, Viola, Cello). Instruments will be provided, for this year, at no additional cost to families. Students will perform throughout the year and may participation in the Grande Prairie and Division Music Festival.

Grade 7-8


Students can choose to participate in the program through their elective/option classes. Sites will offer Band and Orchestra courses as enrolment allows. In these classes students will focus on building skills and advancing their learning on their instrument of choice. Performances are scheduled regularly throughout the year and will include the Grande Prairie and Division Music Festival. Students who participate in the grade 7–8 program can continue their musical development in Band, Orchestra, Guitar, Choir, and Musical Theatre courses that are offered in High School.
