



# THE UNITED WAY ALBERTA NORTHWEST GPPSD FRIENDS OF EDUCATION NOMINEE

The Board was proud to nominate The United Way Alberta Northwest (UWAN) for the Division's 2023 – 2024 Alberta School Board Associations' (ASBA) Zone 1 Friend of Education award.

This nomination reflects their longstanding support across various programs, enhancing student success.

Each year, the United Way runs its Tools 4 School campaign, supporting students who could use a hand-up. In 2023, through leadership and connection, they helped donors fill 1,200 backpacks for 96 schools across 30 communities.

#### 2025 - 2028 GPPSD **CAPITAL PLAN**

Norm Guindon, Associate Superintendent of Business Services, presented to the Board the 2025 - 2028 GPPSD Capital Plan for review and approval.

Using evidence of student enrollment trends and capital planning guidelines from the province to make their decision, the Board passed a motion to approve the following projects to be submitted to Alberta Education:

- 1. Grande Prairie Composite High School permanent addition
- 2. Charles Spencer High School permanent addition
- 3. New Kensington Area K 8 school
- 4. Crystal Park School Modernization

The request for additional high school space is necessitated because of enrollment growth pressures at both schools.

# ELEMENTARY REPORT CARD AND CURRICULUM WORKING GROUPS UPDATE

The Board heard that the Division Elementary Report Card Working Group has met three times to review outcomes and format to align with the new curriculum and support clear communication with families. The committee will review feedback collected from Kindergarten to Grade 6 teachers, school leaders, and the community in April.

The Division Literacy and Numeracy Working Groups have also met, with each working group aiming to complete a draft framework for each area of the curriculum.

By the end of June, the framework will be used as a common resource for guiding instruction in each area, and teachers will use it next school year.
