Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must:

- Be currently enrolled in a grade 12 program in a regional high school offering a French Second Language program.

Preference will be given to candidates who:

- Have taken French Immersion/FSL courses throughout their high school program (number of courses taken)
- Actively participate in community activities (preferably using French in these activities)
- Demonstrate leadership in areas related to the promotion of French language and culture.
- Demonstrate a sound academic record.
- Will be continuing with post-secondary studies in French, if applicable.

Application Process

Documents to include in your application:

- A cover letter, written in French, introducing yourself and including contact information. In the letter, be sure to speak to how you meet the outlined criteria as well as the influence of the French Language on your life and how it will be a part of your future.
- A letter of recommendation from a teacher who taught you a subject in French or a member of the community involved in the promotion of the French Language and culture.
- A copy of your high school transcript.
- If applicable, proof of application/registration at a recognized post-secondary francophone or bilingual institution where you have registered to take courses in French.
