



Outbreak Notification

November 19, 2020

Dear Parent / Guardian,

We have been notified that a case of COVID-19 has been diagnosed in an individual from Crystal Park School. The school is identified as 'Outbreak Status' because there has been more than one case at the site within a fourteen-day period.

The school remains open to in-person learning for students, and we are working closely with AHS to ensure necessary measures are in place to protect all students and staff. This includes cleaning and disinfecting key space and removing and storing items that cannot be cleaned and disinfected.

School administration has reached out to families whose students have been identified as close contacts to the individual. If you have not received a phone call your student has not been identified as a close contact at this time and can continue to attend in-person classes. Alberta Health Services will be contacting parents/guardians of students, as well as any staff/visitors/volunteers who may have been in close contact with the individual who has tested positive. It is important that we respect the confidentiality of the individual.

Any students who may be directed to quarantine by AHS will be supported by the school during the designated period.

We remind everyone to self-monitor for any signs or symptoms of COVID-19. The Alberta Health daily checklist can be found [here](#).
