

Composite High School Learning Continuity Plan

The Alberta Government has declared that schools can re-open under scenario one near-normal operations. This scenario is different than the cancellation of classes on March 13. It is important to note that students are expected to be proactive in their learning by accessing your Google classroom and completing all required work if you are absent in scenario one.

Teachers will be using Google classroom to support students if a student or the teacher is unable to attend due to COVID19. This platform's versatility will allow students and families to access tools and activities provided by the teacher for review or practice. All students should have already signed up for Google classroom and have accessed it with their teacher. If you have not accessed Google classroom, please contact your teacher.

To access Google classroom from home, please ensure that you are logged in to your school account. (not your personal Google account) When you have logged in, ensure that notifications are turned on.

The following table summarizes the responsibilities of the school and family/student.

Responsibilities of family/student:

- Access Google classroom and keep pace with content provided when absent
- Inform teacher and or school of technical difficulties
- If you do not have access to technology, please contact the school.
- Regular communication with teachers when needed.
- Be proactive in learning students will have accessed and be familiar with Google classroom.

Responsibilities of school:

- Teacher will ensure communication on how to access Google classroom when absent from class.
- Ensure all students have accessed their Google classroom before the absence.
- Ensure that the class content is updated on Google classroom at the end of each day.
- Be responsive to the student on return to address learning needs.
- Work with the student to complete assessments that have been missed.

Your child will have access to:

- Content covered in class on specific days.
- Assignments that are expected to be completed.
- Lesson materials to support student learning.

It may include:

- Feedback provided to students.
- Assessment of content covered.

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- Live/recorded instruction.

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
