<b>FRENCH 7 or 8</b>	This course begins the second phase of the French curriculum. Students who have not taken French 7 generally do not enroll in French 8. Students wishing to take French 8 who have not taken French 7 must meet with an administrator and the French teacher. <b>This is an all year course.</b>
<b>BAND 7/8</b>	This course is a continuation of Gr 6 Band. Students will develop advanced playing techniques, work on team building, listening, performance and reading skills. Students will play many styles of music including classical, movie and popular music. Students with no experience can participate and must speak to an administrator prior to enrolling. Band is a performance-oriented class and it is expected that students will attend all performances. <b>This is an all year course.</b>
<b>ORCHESTRA 7/8</b>	This course is a continuation of Gr 5/6 Orchestra. Students will develop advanced playing techniques, work on team building, listening, performance and reading skills. Students will play many styles of music including classical, movie and popular music. Students with no experience can participate and must speak to an administrator prior to enrolling. Orchestra is a performance class and it is expected that students will attend all performances. <b>This is an all year course.</b>
<b>GIUITAR 7/8</b>	Students will learn the basics of guitar and have an opportunity to work on their skills as musicians. Students must provide their own guitar for this course. <b>Note: Enrollment in this course is limited. This is an all year course.</b>
<b>CONSTRUCTION7/8</b>	Construction & Design Technology: This course will introduce students to basic woodworking skills and other skills used in the construction industry, with an emphasis on developing safe work habits and hand tools. <b>Note: Enrollment in this course is limited.</b>
<b>ART 7/8</b>	This class begins the student's exploration of art and its elements. The students will work through many different projects, which may include drawing, painting, sculpture and printmaking
<b>Leadership 7/8</b>	This course provides students with opportunities to learn about the characteristics, discipline and actions that are part of being a leader and providing leadership. Students will also be involved in guided, first- hand experience in being responsible for providing leadership for projects, activities and initiatives at the school and in the community.
<b>Sports Performance 7/8</b>	This course focuses on developing individual and team skills to a greater level in sport such as Volleyball, Basketball, and Badminton. Student will also have an opportunity to experience other sports such as Rugby.
<b>FOODS 7/8</b>	This course will introduce students to some of the basic skills used in the home and workplace with respect to Food industries. The emphasis in grade 8 is on developing proper work habits, kitchen measurement and time management. <b>Note: Enrollment in this course is limited.</b>
<b>Business 7/8</b>	Have you ever thought about where you'd like to live someday? The kind of job you'd like to have? What college or university you want to go to? Of course you have. But have you ever thought about how much money you'll need to get the things that you want. Business will teach you various ways to save money, how to do a simple budget, pros and cons of credit, protecting your identity, college, university and trade school options, funding options, suitable jobs, taxes and more. You can't afford not to take this option.
