Background

Employees, students or parents may challenge the appropriateness of curriculum and instructional materials being used in Division schools.

Procedures

Diligent use of the selection guidelines will eliminate most criticism and controversy with regard to learning resources; however, in the event that validity is challenged, these procedures will be followed:

- 1. The material(s) are to be referred to the Principal who shall have the individual challenging the materials complete a Request for Reconsideration Form (Form 251-1). The complaint shall be discussed at the school level and an attempt made to resolve the issue.
- If the issue cannot be resolved, the Principal shall strike a committee to reconsider the challenged material, who shall review the material and make a recommendation to the Principal.
- 3. The committee shall include:
 - 3.1 A parent,
 - 3.2 A teacher, and
 - 3.3 A school-based administrator.
- 4. If the issue is still unresolved, the matter may be referred to the Superintendent and, if appropriate, to the Board.
